
STAINLESS STEEL ACCESSORIES

TOOLBOX COVER KIT, PASSENGER SIDE, 388/389, 2010+

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Open truck hood for easier access to the factory toolbox cover bolts.
- 2. Remove all bolts from the toolbox covers. Set aside for reuse.
- 3. Remove factory panels. Before removing the lower panel, mark the top flange.
- 4. It may be required to remove exhaust elbow cover for Peterbilt 388, 2011+ model.
- 5. Match the geometry of the lower factory panel with the stainless cover. (The small triangular cutout on the flange of the stainless steel cover represents the top of the part.)



- 6. Apply a generous amount of silicone to the factory panel.
- 7. Press factory panel and cover together, ensuring all holes are aligned.
- 8. Remove the upper panel and discard. The stainless panel will replace the factory panel.
- 9. Peel plastic coating around mounting holes of the stainless covers.
- 10. Mount the panels onto the truck starting with the lower panel then the upper panel. Secure panels by threading factory bolts a few turns back into their corresponding holes, if necessary.
- 11. (It is recommended that Blue Locktite is applied to all bolts, securing the toolbox.) Note: not supplied.
- 12. Important: do not over tighten bolts. Stainless covers will sink in, dimpling the parts.
- 13. Remove plastic coating from toolbox panels. Polish with glass cleaner and soft cloth if necessary.
